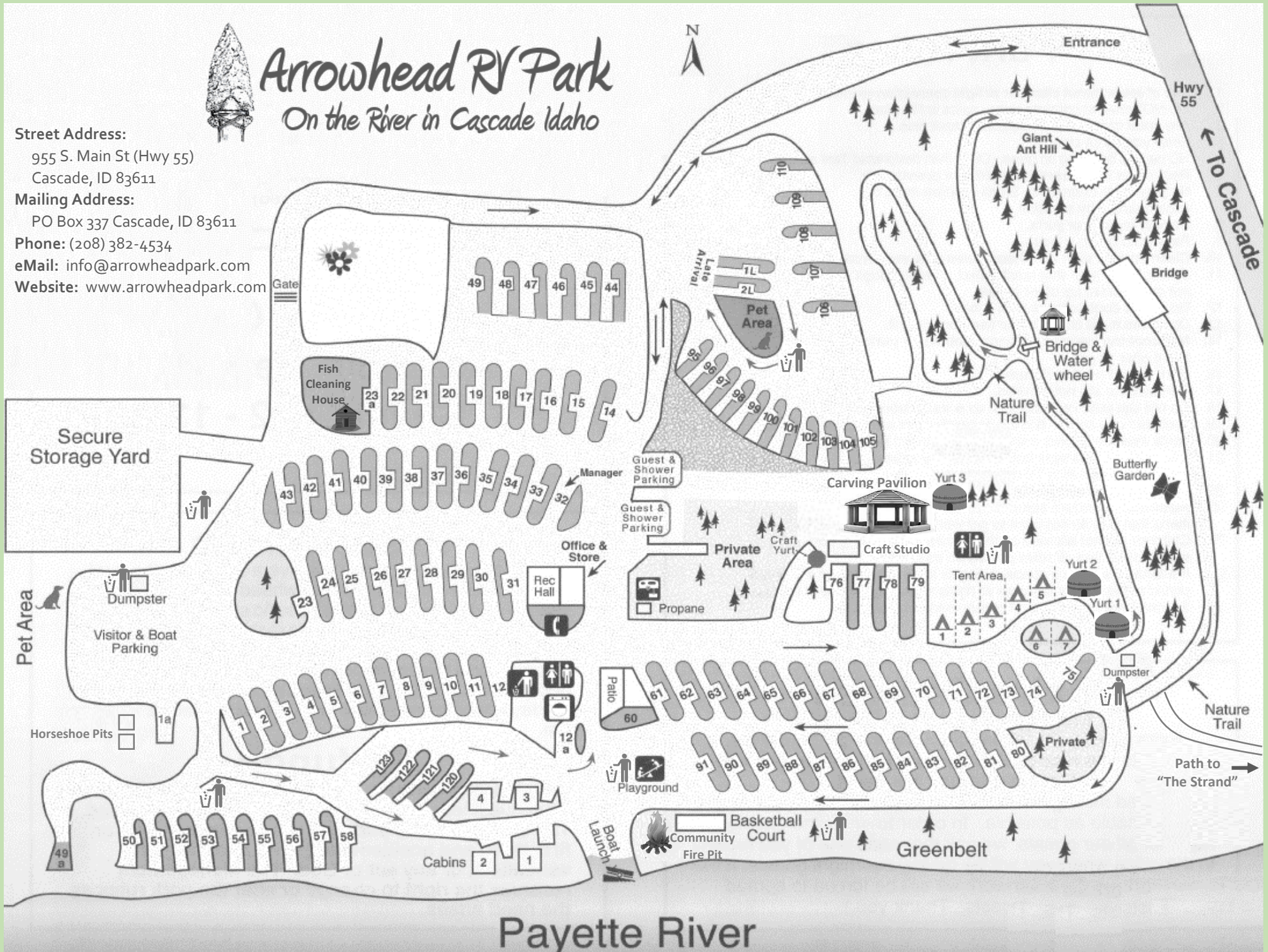

Park Rules

- The owners of this park will not be responsible for fire, theft, damage, vandalism and accidents to persons or property, or any act of God.
- Any damage to Arrowhead property by Guests, their visitors, pets or vehicles will be charged to the Registered Guests card on file.
- Management reserves the right to require any guest to vacate the park for any behavior that disturbs other guests.
- Quiet after 10:00pm until 7:00am. Excessive noise will not be tolerated.
- ALL RV's MUST be escorted to your site by our staff. Pull into Late Night Parking after 9pm. All Tents, Cabins & Yurts must be checked in no later than 9:00pm.
- Keep your area and our facilities clean and respect other guests at all times.
- Visitors must check in at the office for a vehicle pass.
- Restrooms, showers and laundry facilities are for registered guests. Outside visitors please visit the front office.
- Main restrooms are closed starting at 1:00 every day for cleaning. Additional restrooms located by the carving pavilion and tent area.
- No Smoking inside ANY of our park facilities including Cabins and Yurts.
- Park speed limit is 5 MPH. Obey Stop Signs. Watch for Children & Pets. 5MPH NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Children need to be under parental supervision at all times including restrooms & nature trails. Parents are solely responsible for their children's conduct & safety.
- Open fires in fire pits or a free standing unit only. Must be on concrete or gravel and completely extinguished after EVERY USE. Community Fire Pit by the Boat Launch, firewood provided.
- Use of sewer donut elbow or airtight connection required. Parts for sale in the front office.
- Please ONLY use RV safe Toilet Paper in our sewer lines. Do not pour grease down your drains.
- Do not drive over or park on concrete slabs or grass. Additional parking in our overflow lot.
- Screen rooms cannot be staked in the ground and must be approved by management and maintenance in advance. NO TENTS IN RV SPACES.
- Tents can only be put up in the tent area. 1 Adult Tent & 1 Child Size Tent; for children, per site.
- Tents must be moved every 3 days to water and mow the grass.
- DO NOT DRIVE ANY STAKES INTO THE GROUND (tent area OK) to avoid cutting utility lines.
- Prepare for automatic sprinklers that come on every day/night. Some set for twice a day.
- If a tenant vacates a space before the end of the paid up period management reserves all rights to that space. Spaces may not be rented or subleased by tenants. NO REFUNDS for early departure.
- Clotheslines are not allowed.
- Please stay on the trails and do not walk through your neighbor's lot.
- PLEASE respect the Campground Boundaries and any "NO Trespassing Signs"



Pet Policy

If your pet creates a disturbance or is a nuisance to other campers, you may be asked to leave. The pet's owner is responsible for any expenses and liability related to a pet attack or damage inside Arrowhead Park. We hope you will continue to help us with our efforts in keeping our park clean and pet friendly by following our Pet Rules below:

- Your pets shall remain in your CONTROL and visual observation at ALL times.
- Pets must be on a controllable leash at ALL times.
- Clean up after your pet immediately. All droppings must be sealed in a bag and disposed of in the trash.
- Dogs should NEVER be left tied up or unattended outside.
- No pets in any park facilities including Cabins or Yurts.
- Excessive barking, aggressive behavior and noise that is disruptive to other guests in the park is not acceptable.
- Pets may NOT be tied to any trees, pedestals, hydrants, street lights, signs or ANY property structures.
- Be aware and respect other guests and pet owners walking their dogs when exploring our beautiful park.
- Keep pets away from flower beds, gardens & Totem Poles.



OHV/ATV Policy

We have many OHV trails surrounding Arrowhead so please do not ride your OHV around the park. Always show respect to our other guests when entering and exiting the park. Pick up local OHV trail maps in the office or Ranger Station. To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all of our guests please follow our OHV park rules:

- You may use your OHV to enter/exit the park through the Main Entrance ONLY.
- NO Riding In the Park
- YOU MUST STAY ON DESIGNATED ROADWAYS AT ALL TIMES
- NEVER Ride on our Grass
- OHV's must OBEY NO TRESPASSING SIGNS
- All OHV's must be parked within the confines of your campsite driveway
- Additional OHV and Trailer parking available in overflow.
- All riders must adhere to Idaho State and local laws including applicable OHV registration/plates, helmet and age restrictions.
- Any OHV deemed excessively loud may be restricted from operation within the park.
- The OHV's owner is responsible for any expenses and liability related to damage inside Arrowhead RV Park.

Mountain Wi-Fi

We have VERY LIMITED bandwidth up here in the mountains. Wi-Fi signal varies throughout the park. All of our wireless access points start with ARROWHEAD and do not require a password to log on.
